TYPES OF ACTIVITY REQUIRING APPROVAL

Part A – Entertainment Venue (previously known as Places of Public Entertainment)

**** Require Development Application Approval ****

Part B - Water, Sewerage and Stormwater Work.

- B1 Carry out water supply work.
- B2 Draw water from a Council water supply or a standpipe or sell water so drawn.
- B3 Install, alter, disconnects or removes a meter connected to a service pipe.
- B4 Carry out sewerage drainage work.
- B5 Carry out stormwater drainage work.
- B6 Connect a private drain or sewer with a public drain or sewer under the control of a Council or with a drain or sewer which connects with such a public drain or sewer.

Part C - Management of Waste.

- C1 For fee or reward, transport waste over or under a public place.
- C2 Place waste in a public place.
- C3 Place a waste storage container in a public place.
- C4 Dispose of waste into a sewer of the Council.
- C5 Install, construct or alter a waste treatment device or a human waste storage facility or a drain connected to any such device or facility.

Part D - Community Land

- D1 Engage in a trade or business.
- D2 Direct to produce a theatrical, musical or other entertainment for the public.
- D3 Construct a temporary enclosure for the purpose of entertainment.
- D4 For fee or reward, play a musical instrument or sing.
- D5 Set up, operate or use a loudspeaker or sound amplifying device.
- D6 Deliver a public address or hold a religious service or public meeting.

Part E - Public Road

- E1 Swing or hoist goods across or over and part of a public road by means of a lift, hoist or tackle projecting over the footway.
- E2 Expose or allow to be exposed (whether for sale or otherwise) any article in or on or so as to overhang any part of the road or outside a shop window or doorway abutting the road, or hang an article beneath an awning over the road.

Part F - Other Activities.

- F1 Operate a public car park.
- F2 Operate a caravan park or camping ground.
- F3 Operate a manufactured home estate.
- F4 Install a domestic oil or solid fuel heating appliance, other than a portable appliance.
- F5 Install or operate amusement devices (within the meaning of the Construction Safety Act 1912).
- F6 Install or operate amusement devices prescribed by the regulations in premises.
- F7 Use a standing vehicle or any article for the purpose of selling any article in a public place.
- F8 Operate an undertaker's business.
- F9 Operate a mortuary.
- F10 Carry out an activity prescribed by the regulations or an activity of a class or description prescribed by the regulations.
