Council grants permission to this road opening permit application subject to the following conditions:

- In accordance with sections 138 and 139 of the Roads Act, 1993, it is an offence for any person/organisation to open a roadway without Council's approval, in accordance with the conditions of this permit and payment of the appropriate fees. On request by Council Officers this permit is to be produced
- Before commencing and during works, barricades and warning signs are to be used for traffic and pedestrian safety in accordance with Australian Standards 1742.3. RMS Road Occupancy Licence will be required on State and Regional Roads or within 100m of traffic facilities including traffic signals, roundabouts, medians, pedestrian crossings, by contacting RMS on (02) 8396 1513 during office hours (8am to 4pm) or 131 700 after hours.
- Provide and maintain sediment control devices around street stormwater pits and below soil stockpiles. All excess material to be removed from site
- The road and gutters to be swept regularly during the works. Grass footways are to be restored to original condition using top soil and turf
- Temporary roadway restorations shall be bituminous cold mix or AC10 of a maximum thickness 50mm, on a base of DGB20 road base or other material approved by Council's Restorations Supervisor compacted in 100mm layers to a minimum thickness of original pavement thickness + 100mm. Note compaction testing costs incurred are charged to the Restorations.
- Temporary footway area and vehicular crossing restorations shall be bituminous cold mix or AC10 of a minimum thickness 30mm, on a base of DGB20 road base or other material approved by Council's Restorations Supervisor, compacted to a minimum thickness of existing pavement thickness + 100mm.
- Additional fees for Traffic Control on State and Regional Roads may apply, details available on back of form.
- The Applicant shall indemnify Council, by current Public Liability Insurance (\$20 million dollars minimum) and shall be responsible for any injury or loss, which the Council or any persons may suffer through this road opening. A certificate of currency is required with this Application. **Canterbury Bankstown Council must be listed as the interested party on the certificate of currency.**
- All road registered vehicles and plant used at any time in connection with the Road Opening Works must have current motor vehicle insurance covering third party property damage (\$20 million dollars minimum).
- Council carries out all permanent restorations in the City of Canterbury Bankstown Local Government Area. Council's permanent restoration work complies with Aus-Spec 2/NSW -221 Pipe Drainage, Aus-Spec 2/NSW306U Road Openings and Restorations and Council's Standard Drawings. Standard Drawings available to download from Council's website.
- Where it is necessary to carry out restoration work outside normal business hours (e.g. due to traffic constraints on major road or in town centre), an additional fee will apply to scheduled restoration rates.
- Road restoration cost beyond the minimum fee will be charged in increments of 0.2 square metre. For roadway restorations, allow an additional 0.3 metre either side of the trench for bridging (Refer standard drawings S108 and S108A). With regards to footpath, restoration of trench shall be from joint to joint and full width of footpath.
- After completion of temporary restoration contact Council's Restoration Supervisor to arrange final site inspection and permanent restoration on 9707 9000 or Fax 9707 9700**
